Please let us know if your room doesn't need to be cleaned - this could save up to 5 litres of water per room per day.

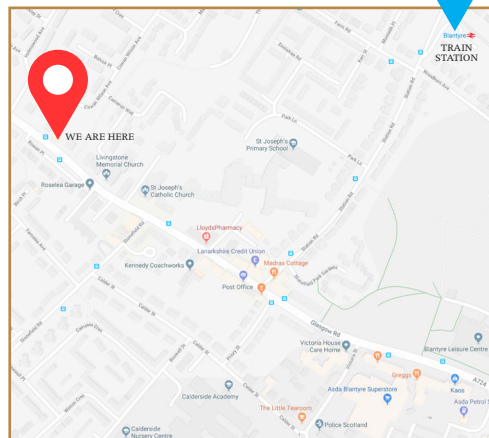

TRAVELLING AROUND BLANTYRE TO AND FROM GLASGOW OR EDINBURGH CITY CENTRE

Travelling around Blantyre is easy due to the excellent transport links in place. Blantyre train station will take you into Hamilton and Glasgow City Centre where you can change lines to Edinburgh. Blantyre train station is only a 10 minute walk or a few minutes taxi journey from The Parkville Hotel.

There are buses throughout Blantyre, taking you to all the local areas.

The M8 which takes you to Glasgow and Edinburgh is well signposted when you come out of the hotel, however if you need directions please ask at reception.



FIRE ACTION PROCEDURE

Please familiarise yourself with the emergency evacuation procedure in case of fire. This is located on the back of your bedroom door.

ON DISCOVERING A FIRE - DURING THE DAY

RAISE THE ALARM by operating the nearest fire alarm call-point.

EVACUATE THE PREMISES quickly and calmly using the nearest fire exit and proceed towards the assembly point at the left hand side of the main entrance to the car park.

DO NOT collect personal belongings.

ON DISCOVERING A FIRE - OVERNIGHT

As above.

If you have a mobile phone on your person please contact the fire department on 999 to be sure they are aware of the situation once you have reached the Assembly Point.

ASSEMBLY POINT: THE PAVEMENT TO THE LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE MAIN ENTRANCE

ONCE YOU REACH THE ASSEMBLY POINT PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL TOLD IT IS SAFE TO DO SO BY STAFF/FIRE DEPARTMENT.
